

JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

1. INTRODUCTION

The All India Police Sports Control Board (AIPSCB), New Delhi has assigned the responsibility to Central Reserve Police Force to host the **26th All India Police Shooting (AIPDM) Competition 2025-26**. The Competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest Rules and Regulations - AIPDM Shooting Competition Hand Book as amended in March, 2016 issued by the Central Coordination Committee of All India Police Sports Control Board, New Delhi.

2. DATE

The 26th All India Police Shooting (AIPDM) Competition 2025-26 will be held at Group Centre, CRPF, Gurugram, Haryana w.e.f. **22.03.2026 to 30.03.2026**.

3. VENUE

The Competition will be held at the Firing Range of the Group Centre, CRPF, Gurugram, Haryana. The venue is easily accessible by road, train and air. Nearest Railway station is Gurugram & Airport is Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi. Anyone interested in seeing the range may do so through Google Earth with the following co-ordinates :-

6. ACCOMMODATION & MESSING

All participating teams and accompanying officials will receive suitable accommodation at Group Centre, CRPF, Gurugram, Haryana.

Important Requirements:

1. Teams must bring their own bedding and mosquito nets.
2. Please email rank-wise details of all team members/participants to CRPF26AIPSC@gmail.com at the earliest. This will enable us to make appropriate lodging arrangements.

Messing Arrangements:

1. Centralized messing facilities will not be provided.
2. Each team must arrange its own messing setup, including cooks, sweepers, helpers, and utensils. Dry rations and fresh vegetables will be available at Group Centre cooperative shops.
3. LPG gas cylinders will be provided by the Accommodation Arrangement Committee on a refundable security deposit of ₹2,500 per cylinder (refunded upon return).
4. No firewood will be permitted for cooking.

7. RECEPTION & TRANSPORT

All teams arriving by air, train, or bus will be received at Delhi Airport, New Delhi Railway Station, Old Delhi Railway Station, and Gurugram Bus Stand, as applicable, and will be escorted to Group Center Gurugram. A Reception Centre will be established at Group Centre, CRPF, Gurugram, Haryana. It is requested that the arrival and departure details of each team be forwarded in the format as **Appendix-'A'** by 01/03/2026 to the Control Room, GC CRPF Gurugram, on Phone No. 0124-2979503, Mobile/WhatsApp No. 8851490456 and E-mail: CRPF26AIPSC@gmail.com. A liaison officer will be detailed for each team, who will receive the team at the Railway Station/Airport/Bus Stand. The details of the respective liaison officers will be communicated to all teams in advance. Vehicles will be provided for transportation of teams from the Railway Station/Airport/Bus Stand to GC CRPF Gurugram. Teams of all CAPFs, Haryana, Rajasthan, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, and Himachal Pradesh police requested to bring their own vehicles for the movement of their officers and team members.

8. CLOTHING & BEDDING

Every team member must carry adequate clothes including uniform, summer bedding and mosquito net for a comfortable stay.

9. SECURITY DEPOSIT & ENTRY FEE

On arrival at Group Centre, CRPF, Gurugram, Haryana, each team will have to deposit Rs 1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) as Security Deposit.

The entry fee for the competition will be Rs. 100/- (Rupees hundred only) per participant including Reserves, Managers, Coaches and Other Members. It is requested that entry fee amount may be remitted through IMPS/NEFT in favor of “**DIG (Adm) NS.**” A/C No. **43525686550, IFSC Code: SBIN0001076, SBI, R.K. Puram, New Delhi.** The last date for sending entries is **01.03.2026**. Receipt of Entry fees paid through any mode of payment may be sent to this office for record.

10. ENTRY FORM & NOMINAL ROLL

The Entry Fee along with 2 copies of Entry Forms and Nominal Rolls duly certified by the competent authority should be sent to the Organizing Secretary, 26th All India Police Shooting (AIPDM) Competition 2025-26, Group Centre, CRPF, Gurugram, Haryana. A Specimen of Entry Form of each competition is enclosed as Appendix "B". A certificate, stating that -

"All the participants are physically and mentally fit to participate in 26th All India Police Shooting (AIPDM) Competition 2025-26 and during the competition, if any participants sustains any injury / grievously hurt, Organizer (CRPF) will not be responsible for it"

- should also be sent along with the entry forms.

The Teams are requested to submit the Entry Form duly completed in all aspects to the Organizing Secretary on or before 01.03.2026 via post or email. The entries in the Entry Form shall not be allowed to be modified after 10.03.2026. **Original copy of the Entry Form should be handed over to the Organizers on arrival at the Venue.**

11. REGISTRATION

Participating teams are requested to register on AIPSCB website. Registration will be opened soon. The date of registration will be intimate later after receipt from AIPSCB. The endeavor of AIPSCB is to encourage maximum participation.

12. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Every competitor participating in the competition should have completed a minimum of one year of continuous service in the respective Police Force in the rank of Constable or above, on the last date of submission of the application to the organizer. **A certificate to this effect must be appended at the bottom of the entry form and should be duly signed by an officer not below the rank of DIG/IG, stating that "All participants have completed a minimum of one year continuous service in..... (Organization name)".** The Entry Form should not contain names of more than the maximum as laid down by the All India Police Sports Control Board, New Delhi.

13. RECCE & FAMILIARISATION BY TEAM REPRESENTATIVES

All teams may send 1-2 Officers/Subordinate Officers and 2-3 HCs/CTs for recce and familiarization between 25.02.2026 and 28.02.2026 at Group Centre, CRPF, Gurugram, Haryana. No visits will be permitted after 28.02.2026.

14. RETURN AIR/TRAIN RESERVATION

Teams can move back on 31.03.2026 after the completion of 26th All India Police Shooting (AIPDM) Competition 2025-26 and can plan their advance Air/Rail reservations accordingly. However, necessary assistance will be provided to all teams.

15. **CONDUCT**

The 26th All India Police Shooting (AIPDM) Competition 2025-26 will be conducted as per AIPDM Shooting Competition Rules & Regulations (Revised up to March, 2016) issued by the Central Coordination Committee of All India Police Duty Meet, New Delhi. If there is any change or modification in Rule position, it will be informed before the conduct of Clinic.

16. **CLINIC MEETING**

A Clinic meeting of the Team Managers, Team Captains, Coaches of Respective Team and Technical officials will be held at the Group Centre, CRPF, Gurugram, Haryana at 1000 Hrs on 23.03.2026. It is compulsory for all the participating Team Managers, Team Captains and Coaches to attend the Clinic meeting.

17. **DRAW OF LOTS**

Draw of Lots will be conducted on 23.03.2026 during the Clinic meeting in the presence of all Technical Committee, Team Managers. Team Captains and Coaches to decide the sequence and timing of the events.

18. **UNIFORM AND IDENTITY CARD**

All participating team members must wear their prescribed working uniforms during the competition, as well as the Opening and Closing Ceremonies. Participants are required to bring their valid Departmental Identity Card issued by their respective State Police, UT Police, or CAPF. No one will be permitted to participate in the Competition without their valid Departmental Identity Card.

19. **OPENING/ CLOSING CEREMONY**

Key Dates (Tentative) :-

Closing Ceremony: Afternoon of 30 March 2026

Uniform Requirement:-

All team/contingent members must wear identical dress during both ceremonies.

Provide your respective State Police / UT Police / Central Armed Police Force flags upon arrival at the Control Room.

Best Discipline (exhibited throughout the competition)

20. DISCIPLINE

A very high standard of discipline is expected from all Officers and members of the participating teams. The Team Managers/Captains will be personally responsible for discipline and orderly conduct of their team during the competition and stay. Use of alcohol, intoxicants and gambling of any kind is strictly prohibited.

21. MEDICAL FITNESS CERTIFICATE

All the participants are required to bring their Health Card/Medical Fitness Certificate issued by their Medical Officer / Doctor within 2 months prior to the conduct of the Competition.

22. PARTICIPATION IDENTITY CARD

The Team Managers of the participating teams should deposit 2 recent passport size photographs in UNIFORM of each participant / official duly attested for the purpose of preparing Participation Identity Cards on arrival at the Group Centre, CRPF, Gurugram, Haryana.

23. SECURITY

In order to ensure security, all officials and members of the teams must carry their Identity cards during their stay at Group Centre, CRPF, Gurugram, Haryana.

24. MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Facility of 10 Bedded hospital is available at Group Centre, CRPF, Gurugram, Haryana. The Medical sub-committee and hospital of GC Gurugram will provide medical back up during conduction of competition.

25. DETAILS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE TEAMS

The participating teams will have to submit the details of their members of the teams to the Organizer in the following formats:-

26. WEAPONS, EQUIPMENT, AMMUNITION AND STORE

Service Weapons without any modifications only should be used for the competitions i.e., 7.62mm SLR/BA, 5.56 INSAS Rifle, AK 47, 303 Rifle, 9mm Pistol, 0.380 Revolver, 9mm Carbine/MP5. Any competitor who uses other than the above mentioned weapon will be disqualified (Rule 2.9.7.1 of All India Police Duty Meet Shooting Competition). Teams will bring their own weapons, equipment, ammunition, stores and should ensure its security. Keeping in view that all Teams would be coming from various extreme climatic zones. Therefore, all teams will be provided facilities to zero their weapons by providing slots for firing range. All teams are requested to bring their Armorer.

27. RULE POSITION IN CASE OF TIE

In case of Individual medals, ties will be decided by counting maximum number of hits in the smallest scoring area followed up step wise to the largest scoring area. If the tie still persist, re-fire will be done till the tie is broken (Rule 3.14.1 of All India Police Duty Meet Shooting Competition)

However, in case of ties for best shot (equal scores) and the team having equal score for Team Championship, a “**JOINT WINNER**” will be declared but the competitor / team having maximum number of hits in the smallest scoring area in all the practices of an event combined together will be awarded Best Shot Medal/Trophy at the venue. The second best (Joint Winner) will be announced and a certificate will be given. Medal for the Joint Best Shot will be sent latter (Rule 3.14.2 of All India Police Duty Meet Shooting Competition). Team Championship Trophy will be shared for 6 months by each.

28. COORDINATION AND CORRESPONDENCE
